

Publishing pupils' coursework

We may wish to celebrate the achievements of pupils and promote the trust through publishing of coursework. When this is the case the trust school will seek the consent of the parent/carer, or where pupils are aged 12 or above, from the pupil themselves. As the trust school are relying on your consent you can withdraw consent at any time by contacting the trust school. Every effort will be made to delete the coursework, but please note that where consent has been provided for the publication, the trust may not be able to locate and delete the coursework on request, although reasonable steps will be taken to do so.

Where consent has been provided for the use of coursework, and the pupil has left the trust school, we will rely on legitimate interests as our legal basis when retaining coursework for promotional purposes.
